ARTICLE X

MISCELLANEOUS

Prohibition on limitations on health care facilities and
services.-

- (a) The state may not limit the number of hospitals, nursing homes, hospices, or intermediate care facilities for individuals with intellectual disabilities, or services provided by these facilities, through the granting of certificates of need.
- (b) Upon the effective date of this section, laws that relate to certificate of need approval for the number of hospitals, nursing homes, hospices, or intermediate care facilities for individuals with intellectual disabilities, or services provided by these facilities are void and of no effect. However, laws that restrict or limit the ownership or licensure of hospitals, nursing homes, hospices, or intermediate care facilities for individuals with intellectual disabilities shall remain in effect.
